



## **FAYETTE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE HVAC REBATE PROGRAM**

The **FEC HVAC REBATE PROGRAM** is designed to encourage energy efficiency in newly constructed homes, the remodeling and renovation of existing homes, and specifically in new installations, replacement, or upgrading cooling systems. The program offers homeowners assistance in the form of relevant information, on-site verification services and financial incentives for qualified equipment.

### **PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND INCENTIVES**

<b>HVAC TYPE AND EFFICIENCY REQUIREMENT</b>	<p>→ <b>Must be heat pump or ground-source heat pump or gas furnace</b></p> <p>→ <b>14 SEER or 14.0 EER minimum</b></p>
<b>INCENTIVES</b>	<p>→ <b>Qualified Heat Pump -- \$150 / unit rebate</b></p> <p>→ <b>Qualified A/C w/ Gas Furnace -- \$100 / unit rebate</b></p> <p>→ <b>Dealer receives -- \$20 per house</b></p>

### **PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

1. Contractor **must** have a valid TACL.
2. FEC member **will** receive the program incentive.
3. Newly constructed and existing homes are eligible.
4. Member has six months after installation of qualified HVAC unit to receive rebate.
5. **Window units and central air-conditioners with electric resistance heat as a primary heating source are not eligible.**

### **PROGRAM PROCEDURES**

1. Dealer **must** notify FEC that a qualifying job is in the installation stage or has been completed by sending completed program forms to FEC.
2. Forms received by FEC.
3. FEC representative verifies new equipment was installed.
4. Incentives processed and mailed to Co-op member.
5. Dealer fee processed and mailed to dealer.
